NEURAL DYNAMICS FOR COGNITIVE ROBOTICS

AUG 28 - SEPT 1, 2017

Neuronal dynamics provide a powerful theoretical language for the design and modelling of embodied and situated cognitive systems. The school is aimed at advanced undergraduate or graduate students, postdocs, and faculty members in embodied cognition, cognitive science, and robotics.

SCOPE

This summer school gives a hands-on introduction to neuronal dynamics ideas and will enable participants to become productive within this framework.

Participants will develop and implement small experimental projects on their own to establish a link to their research interest.

TOPICS

Neural attractor dynamics, dynamic field theory, neuronal representations, navigation behavior, artificial perception, learning mechanisms, implementation issues
