The goal of this conference is to build this new community of social cyber scholars by bringing together and fostering interaction between members of the scientific, corporate, government and military communities interested in understanding, forecasting, and impacting human socio-cultural behavior. It is the charge to this community to build this new science, its theories, methods, and its scientific culture in a way that does not give priority to either social science or computer science, and to embrace change as the cornerstone of the community. Despite decades of work in this area, this scientific field is still in its infancy. To meet this charge and move this science to the next level, this community must meet the following three challenges: 1) deep understanding of socio-cognitive reasoning, 2) human-technology integration, 3) and re-usable computational methods. - Agent-Based Models
- Models of Human-Autonomy Interaction
- Health and Epidemiological Models
- Validation Methods and Human Experimentation

## BEST CONFERENCE PAPER AND BEST STUDENT PAPER AWARD

All accepted and presented full papers will contest for Best Conference Paper Award. Accepted and presented full papers with a student as the first author will be considered for the Best Student Paper Award. Papers will be evaluated on technical merit, originality, and significance to social-cyber applications. Winners will be announced at the conclusion of the conference. \* Program Committee Chair papers are excluded from all Best Paper Awards.

## Present your research at SBP-BRiMS 2022

There are many ways to engage at SBP-BRiMS 2022:

- Present a paper (requires submission and acceptance of a full paper as a presentation)
- Present a poster (requires submission and acceptance of a full paper or abstract as a poster)
- Present a challenge response (requires submission and acceptance of a challenge response abstract)
- Present a didactic seminar (requires submission and acceptance of a tutorial proposal)
- Demo your software (requires attending and mentioning the name of the software you will demo during registration)
- Attend the graduate consortium (requires Ph.D. student submitting a short thesis description)

## What you will need to submit

- Full Papers: Up to 10 pages including references in Springer Template in both PDF format and raw files (.zip for LaTeX or .docx)
- Abstract only: Up to one-page abstracts in Springer Template in both PDF format and raw files (.zip for LaTeX or .docx)

Note: please indicate if the first author is a student

Note: Only original material should be submitted. Commercial papers, papers with no new research/development content, and papers with proprietary restrictions will not be accepted for presentation.

Note: each accepted paper has to have a unique registration. An exception may be made if all paper are single authored.

- Conference Chairs/Editors may require manuscript revision before approving publication and reserve the right to reject for publication any paper that does not meet acceptable standards for a scientific publication. Conference Chairs/Editors decisions on whether to allow publication of a manuscript are final.
